1 MUSEUM - 3 SITES OF REMEMBRANCE - 4 IMMERSIVE EXPERIENCES

Opened in 2014, the Bastogne War Museum has established itself as Belgium's leading centre dedicated to the Second World War and the Battle of the Bulge. Since opening, it has welcomed over 1.7 million visitors.

Over the years, the museum's offer has expanded considerably: from an initial exhibition, the museum now includes four immersive visitor experiences, spread across three complementary memorial sites.

Your ticket grants you access to all these areas. It remains valid for six months for any experience not yet started, offering you great flexibility when visiting.

The museum is open daily from 9.30 am to 6.00 pm (until 7.00 pm in July and August). Groups of more than 20 people benefit from a preferential rate of €18 per person (instead of €28 per person)

★ BASTOGNE WAR MUSEUM (2h00)

Located not far from the famous American Mardasson Memorial, the Bastogne War Museum offers an immersive journey through the Second World War and the Battle of the Bulge, suitable for the whole family.

Four multi-sensory shows, dozens of accounts from civilians and soldiers, hundreds of period artefacts and vehicles, and four endearing characters bring the personal stories at the heart of the wider history to life.



★ GENERATIONS45 (30min)

Follow the journey of two veterans, one American and the other German, **in post-war Europe**, from 1945 to 1989, from the ruins of Bastogne to the fall of the Berlin Wall.



★ **BOIS JACQUES** (30min)

Visit the remains of the Bois Jacques **battlefields** via a virtual reality mobile application. Thanks to this technology, experience the daily life of the GIs entrenched in the original foxholes.



★ **BASTOGNE WAR ROOMS** (1h00)

Dive into the heart of the American resistance during the Battle for Bastogne, surrounded by the atmosphere of the **old headquarters**. The Bastogne War Rooms provide a complete immersion at the heart of this historic site. It is the place where General McAuliffe pronounced his renowned response, **"NUTS!"**, to the German demand to surrender.

Duration : Bastogne War Museum : 2h00 Generations 45 : 30min

Bois Jacques : 30min Bastogne War Rooms : 1h00

GROUP ENTRANCE FEE (starts from 20 people): €18 per person

Accompanied by an audioguide, visitors (re)discover the Second World War and the Battle of the Bulge through the lives of 4 characters and 3 multi-sensory cinemas.

In "Generations 45", follow the lives of two veterans in postwar Europe, from 1945 to 1989.

Outside, visit the Bois Jacques battlefield with a virtual reality mobile app.

End your visit at the Bastogne War Rooms in the atmosphere of the American headquarters.

The complete museum tour can be taken at two different times of the day.

Guided tours of the battlefields

Duration : 2h00 Price : €300 per guide

Accompanied by a local guide, learn more about the sites that pay tribute to the valiant soldiers of the Ardennes Offensive, such as the Bois de la Paix, the German military cemetery at Recogne, the battlefield of Bois Jacques (mobile app), etc.

Provide your own means of transport.

Possibility of increasing the duration of the activity and the number of sites visited.

Complement your Museum experience with other outdoor activities such as historical walks or a ride in a vintage military vehicle. In addition, our partners (breweries, chocolate factories, animal parks, etc.) help you to discover other facets of the Ardennes.

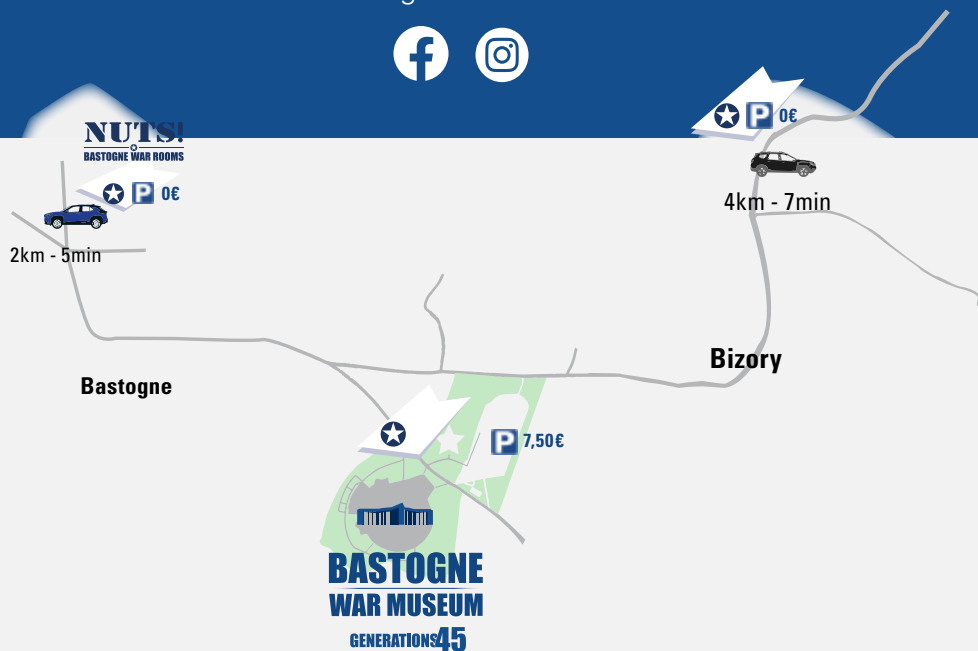
